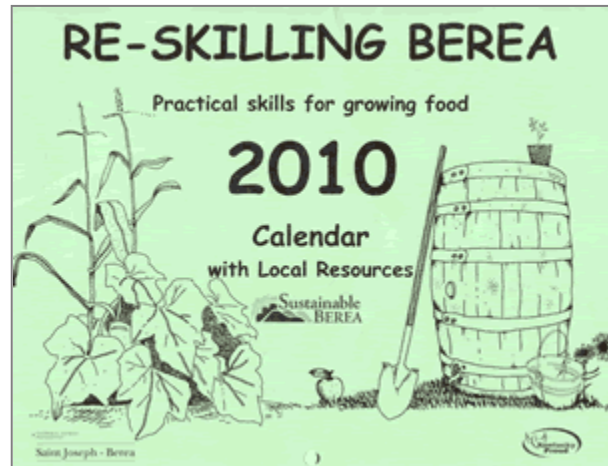


# 2010 Re-skilling/Food and Gardening Calendars For Sale!
